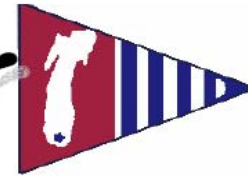

Piloting Class is now in session on Wednesday evenings and taught by Tom Sharp and Larry Fleck

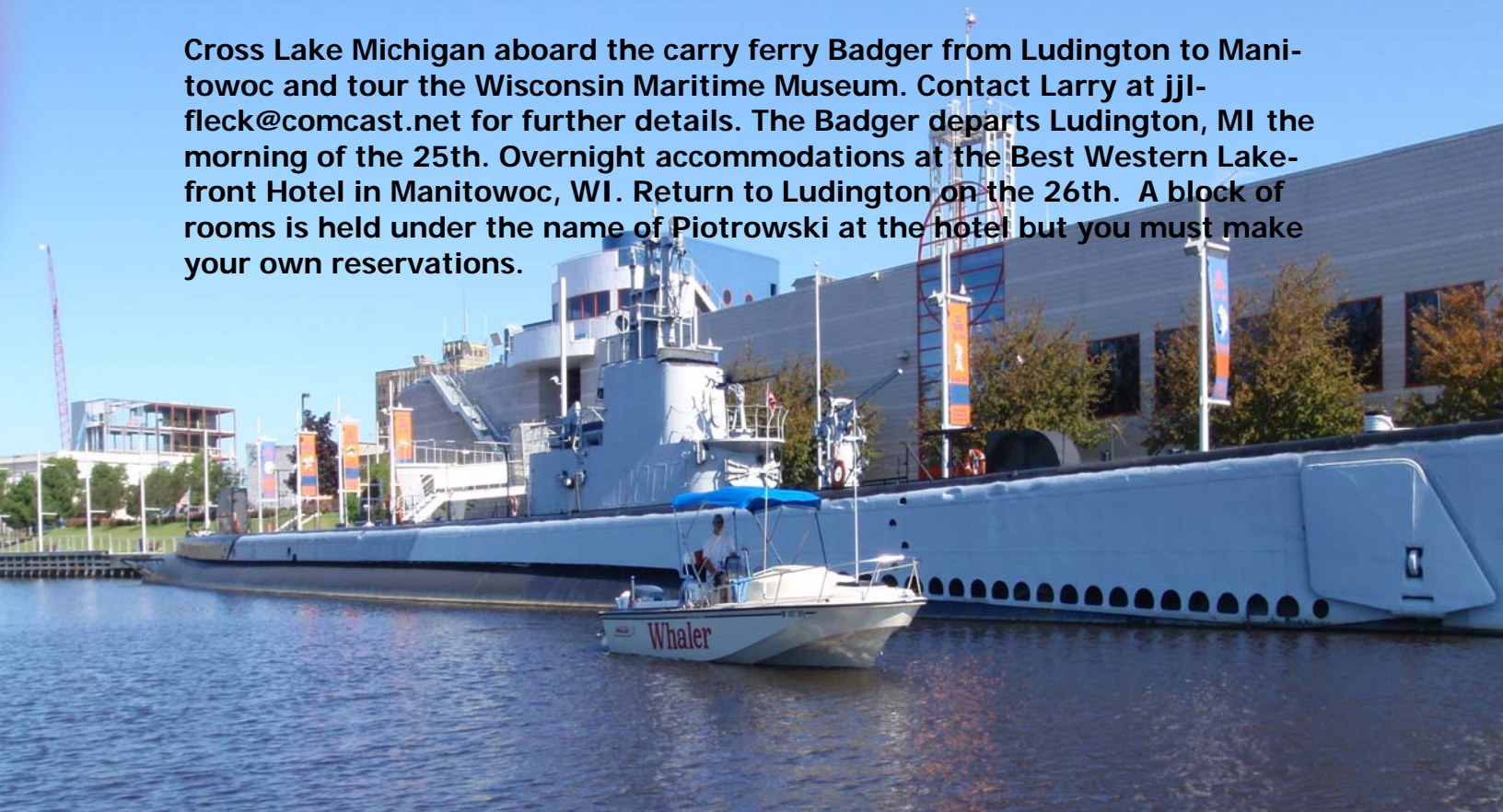

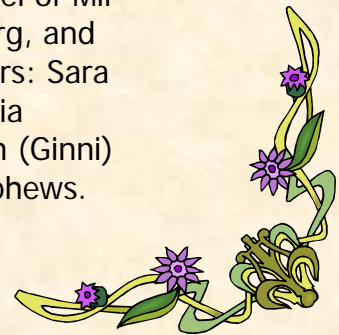
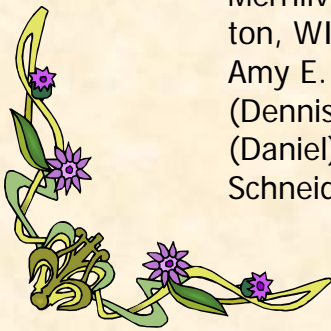
